

Ears

- Ears coming out over the eye. Visor-like. Firm, and in control of the ears.
- This hog moved the ears slightly to the side to better see what is approaching. The hog is comfortable in its present environment so the ears seem relaxed and not on alert.
- Erect in the breed standard description means firm. Not floppy but may be when the hog is in motion.
- Ears may be in different positions depending on what the hog is doing or what is going on around it.
